1. Purpose of Recruitment and Research Category

In addition to encouraging ambitious students in their research activities, we support individual student's research in order to develop their research planning and improve their verbal/non-verbal presentation skills. The research plans that can be implemented within one-year study period will be selected for recruitment.

2. Qualification Requirements

First or second grade students' individual research.

In particular, Research Projects which will be recognized worldwide are most welcome. It excludes students who have adopted student project expenses in the past. In addition, priority is given to students who have not been accepted by a research internship to a partner school using the Dean's discretionary expenses or by a special researcher of the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science.

4. Budget Allotment

300,000 yen per research project
