8. 旅費支給について【弘前・山形・福島大学配属学生のみ対象】

弘前大学,山形大学,福島大学配属の学生には,実施後に,交通費(陸路計算)及び前泊の宿泊費(10月16日(木)分7,800円)を支給します。

- (1) 交通費(陸路計算)は、「自宅から集合場所まで」と「配属大学住所から集合場所まで」とを 比べて、近距離(旅程上安価な場合も含む)である方を基に計算した額を補助支給します。<u>な</u> お、自家用車使用の場合は、宿泊費も含め支給対象外です。

Announcement for 2025 Academic Year's 'Tohoku Agricultural Seminars'

The 2025 "Tohoku Agricultural Seminars" (selection, 1 credit) will be held as on-site training for 2 days and 1 night as described below. The training theme is "Forest, Sea, and People - Co-creating a Sustainable Future through Local Resource".

We will visit Kirikirikoku (https://kirikirikoku.org/), a nonprofit organization in Otsuchi Town, Iwate Prefecture, known for its forest restoration and disaster education activities that emphasize the connection between forest and sea. Through this visit, we will explore sustainable community building and solutions to local challenges by utilizing regional resources.

- 1. Date: October 17 (Fri) 18 (Sat), 2025
- 2. Venue: Otsuchi Town, Iwate Prefecture (NPO Kirikirikoku, Ando community center)
- 3. Eligibility: Students who have participated in the "Science Communication Camp". (Including prospective participants of the "2025 Science Communication Camp")

15:00-17:00	Group work (Discussion)

5. Participation fee: 8,000 yen (cost for the guest house (including two meals; dinner & breakfast) and drink during the exchange program).

8. Travel Expenses [Only for students who belong to Hirosaki, Yamagata, and Fukushima University]

Students assigned to **Hirosaki University**, **Yamagata University**, **and Fukushima University** will be provided with transportation expenses (land route calculation) and accommodation expenses for the previous night (i.e. October 16, 7,800 yen for one night) after the implementation.

- (1) Transportation costs (land route calculation) are based on the shortest distances (including calculating the cheaper itinerary) by comparing "from home to meeting place" and "from assigned university address to meeting place". The calculated amount will be subsidized to the students. If you use your private vehicle, travel expenses, including accommodation fee, will not be paid.
- (2) Please make your own arrangements for tickets and accommodation for the night before (Thursday, October 16, 2025). Please note that participants are required to submit a receipt or an accommodation certificate showing the name of the accommodation/hotel facility (with the accommodation facility seal) and the name of the person staying at the facility.

* We will not pay any transportation and accommodation fees for the night of October 16 to the students affiliated with Iwate University.

9. Notes

There is no subsidy for the participation fee (8,000 yen).

Please note that changes such as attendance after submitting the course registration are not permitted unless it is unavoidable.

Since you will be staying at a local guesthouse, lodging will be in shared rooms with other students

(Men and women in separate rooms). The bathrooms will be shared by other men and/or women (no individual shower available). However, once you confirm with others, you can proceed alone when the bath is available.

If there is any restriction with food such as some allergies or religion concerns, please write them in the application form.
